### **Course Description**

This course is designed to acquaint professionals working with children with neuro-motor impairment with an introduction to the Neurodevelopmental Treatment Approach. Participants will experience typical development and atypical development, broadening their understanding of the movement challenges faced by their clients. Practicums and treatment demonstrations will augment didactic instruction.



#### **Course Objectives**

- 1. To develop a greater understanding of the required prerequisite sensory motor components and patterns of development in the first 12 months.
- 2. To understand the typical postures and movement patterns demonstrated by children with abnormal tone.
- 3. To increase awareness of selected functional consequences of abnormal tone, as related to typical motor development.
- 4. To understand the basic principles of Neurodevelopmental theory.
- 5. To develop a basic understanding of the facilitation of movement and acquire a basic level of competence in facilitating movement.
- 6. To demonstrate a basic understanding of postural reflex mechanism.

### **Treating the Movement Challenges of Children with ASD**

19th - 20th JANUARY 2017 (Thu - Fri)

#### **Course Description**

The movement challenges of Autism are often neglected in the treatment perspective offered by the Occupational Therapist or Physical Therapist working with children with ASD. Current motor control literature and neurobiological research highlight the motor systems impairments in this growing population

of epidemic proportion. Neuro-Developmental Treatment is a frame of reference guiding therapists in their understanding of the analysis and treatment of posture and movement traditionally in children with cerebral palsy. This course will take the concepts of NDT and bridge them into the analysis and treatment of posture and movement in ASD. Comparison and contrast between ASD motor patterns and typical development will be highlighted offering a basis for the facilitation of new motor learning through hands on practical labs. This is an introductory/intermediate level course.



### **Course Objectives**

- 1. The learner will acquire a preliminary understanding of the neurobiology of movement disorders in ASD.
- 2. The learner will develop an introductory understanding of the concepts of Neuro-Developmental Treatment.
- 3. The learner will acquire a comparative understanding between typical motor development and the motor control issues in ASD.
- 4. The learner will acquire introductory skills in hands on facilitation of movement patterns in the children with Autism Spectrum Disorder.


