What is Irlen® Syndrome?

Irlen® Syndrome (also named *Meares-Irlen Syndrome*, *Scotopic Sensitivity Syndrome*, and *Visual Stress*) is a **perceptual processing disorder**. It is not an optical problem. It is a problem with the brain's ability to process visual information. This problem tends to run in families and is not currently identified by other standardized educational or medical tests.
